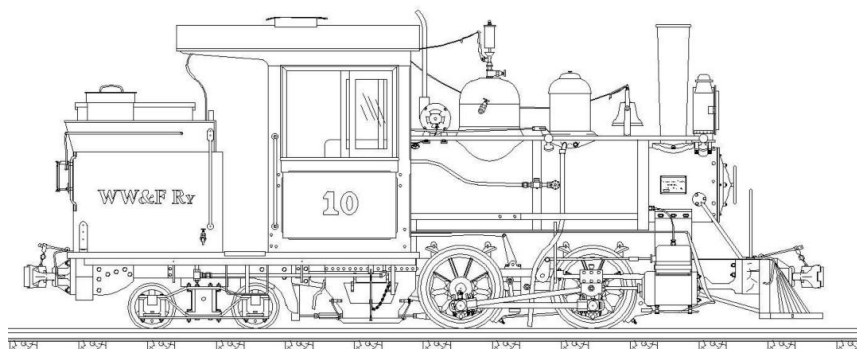

Built 1904 by the Vulcan Iron Works Wilkes-Barre, PA
1904-1958 Served as a 30" gauge sugar plantation engine in Louisiana
1958-1998 Sold to Edaville in South Carver, MA gauged 24"
1960s saw service at the Pleasure Island amusement park, Waterford MA
1998 sold to the W-W&F Railway Museum received overhaul and restoration.

Install an O Scale O Gauge Truck with Shorter Wheelbase.

Set the Steam Cylinders and Drivers at 32 mm Gauge for Operation on SM32 Track at 1:22.5 Scale.

$22.5 * 32 \text{ mm} = 720 \text{ mm} = 28 \text{ inch Gauge Track.}$
